The Texas company owns more than 99% of the remaining stock that came from the original factory in Northern Ireland. It also has the original technical drawings of the car. The new DeLorean is set to hit the roads in 2017.

Originally a DeLorean cost US\$85,000 and was stainless steel in colour! Today, a second hand DeLorean costs US\$35,000 to US\$50,000 (£25,000 to £35,000). Right-hand drive versions can go for more. The new car is expected to sell for around US\$100,000.

The original DeLorean Motor Company was owned by John DeLorean. Production challenges and delays meant the car arrived on the market with an underpowered car. Just 9,200 were produced before the company went bust. Some 6,000 still survive.
